


## Jelly Roll Giant Log Cabin



These stunning quilts are made from rounds of 2.5" strips of fabric stitched as for a log cabin alternating with plain contrasting strips 1.5" wide. You can choose to make a rectangular quilt (53" by 63") suitable for a single bed quilt or a throw or a square double bed quilt (68")

### Fabrics

For either quilt: One Jelly roll – at least 40 strips 2.5" wide

Rectangle quilt: 1.75m contrasting plain or tone on tone fabric

The binding for this quilt could be made from leftover jelly roll strips or 0.5m toning fabric

Backing: 3m of 42" wide fabric or 1.6m of 60" wide fabric

Wadding: at least 60" by 70"

Square quilt 2m contrasting plain or tone on tone fabric

Binding 0.5m toning fabric

Backing: 3.75m of 42" wide fabric or 2m of fabric at least 75" wide

Wadding: at least 75" by 75"

### Cutting

Rectangle quilt: cut 23 strips across the width of the fabric 1.5" wide and 7 strips 2" wide

Square quilt: cut 33 strips across the width of the fabric 1.5" wide and 8 strips 2" wide

### Rectangle Quilt

Start by cutting a strip 12½" long from a jelly roll strip

Stitch a 12½" strip of plain fabric to one side of this


Sew a 3½" strip to one end of the two previous strips

Add a third and fourth strip in the style of a log cabin block to complete the first round

The next round will be sewn with jelly roll strips –join on another strip as needed as you work the round.

Continue adding rounds, alternating the plain and jelly roll strips, until 9 rounds of jelly roll strips are complete.

Use the 2" plain strips for the final round.




### Square Quilt

Start by cutting a 7½" square of plain fabric

Add a round of jelly roll fabric in the same style as the instructions above

Continue adding rounds until 10 jelly roll rounds are complete

Add a final round using the 2" plain strips



Layer and quilt by stitching along the centre of each plain round.

Bind using either the leftover jelly roll strips or 2½" strips of a toning fabric to complete your quilt.
